- 1) DPS Inspections:
 - **a.** Has the State of Texas announced potential DPS inspections at Colombia as it has initiated in ports like Eagle Pass, TX and El Paso?
- 2) Government Shutdown: Potential Impact to the Port of Laredo:
 - a. Has CBP identified which personnel would be affected as far as Exempt, Non-exempt, and Accepted in case of a government shutdown and how it will impact the Trade?
- 3) Impact of Immigration Issue Upriver:
 - a. How has the immigration issue impacting the ports of Del Rio and Eagle Pass, TX impacted Laredo?
 - b. Are CBP officers being sent to assist with processing of immigrants?

- 4) Change of fiscal year Points of Contacts at WTB and Colombia:
 - a. With the new fiscal year for CBP, are there any changes in personnel we need to be made aware of?
- 5) CBPF7533, Inward Cargo Manifests required at other ports:

At other ports within the old "district," member customs brokers are concerned with the lack of consistency. The port of Pharr, TX requires that drivers have a copy of the Inward Cargo Manifest on hand that according to them, in case of an ACE outage or lack of SCN match, officers can reference the correct Entry, etc...

- a. Will the port of Laredo, TX also require that drivers have the Inward Cargo Manifest?
- b. Can the CBP DFO advise what is being done about the lack of consistency?
- 6) Penalties issued to Drayage Carries on "Entry not declared" on ACE eManifests. The recurring issue of carriers not declaring all Entries on an ACE eManifest leads to a penalty against the carrier, even though customs brokers are voluntarily making these requests to CBP.
 - a. Can CBP revisit the issue of these voluntary declarations that ultimately lead to penalties since it is affecting a customs brokers' willingness to make these voluntary declarations when they discover their Entries have not been arrived through no fault of the broker?
 - b. Can CBP suggest best practices for this recurring issue/topic?
- 7) Penalties due to multiple WPM stamps when pallets are reworked. Whenever CBP Agriculture detects an actionable pest, shipments have been reexported to Mexico and pallets retreated or fumigated. A member customs broker indicated that they were penalized since the pallets were stamped with an additional treatment stamp.
 - a. Can CBP explain why this is a penalized occurrence?
 - b. Can CBP Agriculture suggest best practices whenever this happens?
