ARTICLE ONE

Clerk of  
Corporations Section

The name of the corporation is THE LAREDO LICENSED U.S. CUSTOMS BROKERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR
